COURSE CONTENT

Road Markings constitute possibly the single most important device to ensure safe and traffic-efficient roadways. They are certainly the most neglected form of Road Traffic Signs both in terms of correct application and maintenance.

This course sets out a comprehensive explanation of the requirements of the SADC-RTSM In-depth discussion on all the Road Marking types, as well as a guide to the use of the various Volumes and Chapters contained in SARTSM.

Exercises in problem solving, good practice guides and recommendations will be presented. Rural and Urban applications will be investigated. Emphasis will also be placed on the correct method of preparing drawings and problems encountered at the pre-marking stage.
